

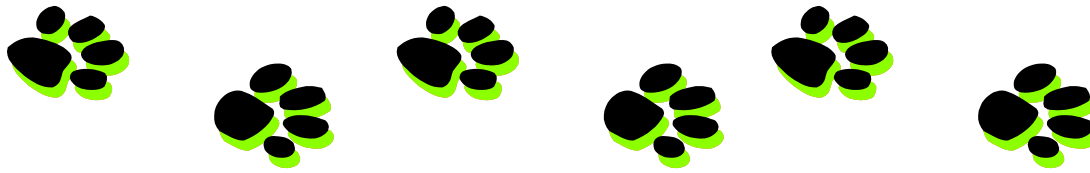
# TIGER TRAFFIC TALK

Please go over these drop-off and pick-up procedures for children who are driven to school and **be sure all drivers in your family, including babysitters, are familiar with them.** We need everyone to follow these rules consistently to keep traffic moving and our children safe.

## Using the Drop-Off Zone on Daymon Terrace

- If you are planning to drop-off your child on Daymon Terrace, you **must** use the **Drop-Off Zone, which is staffed by volunteers from 8:30am to 8:50am.** The designated drop-off area is **only** between the doors on each side of the Kindergarten playground.
- You may not drop-off in front of or beyond the designated area as this causes traffic jams. **If you do not want to use the designated Drop-Off Zone, please find a legal parking space before allowing your child to leave the car.**
- To use the Drop-Off Zone, five or six cars at a time pull forward, close to the curb, into the Drop-Off zone. Wait while your child gets out of the car, signal with your blinker, and then pull away from the curb **only after the car in front of you has pulled away from the curb.** Then the next group of five or six cars can do the same. **Do not try to bypass cars already in the drop-off zone either on the way in or out of the zone.** Please be patient.
- Children should exit their cars **ONLY** through the passenger side at the curb. Two or three adult volunteers will be there to assist them. Please encourage all children to be ready to get out of the car. ***Parents who need to take their children out of the cars themselves or escort their children into the school must continue past the drop-off zone and find legal parking further down the street. Drivers may not leave their cars for any reason. This Drop-off Zone is to be used only by drivers who remain in their vehicles at all times.***
- Children need to be independent enough to leave their car with minimal assistance and get to their classrooms by themselves to use the Daymon Terrace Drop-Off. Kindergartners, in general, are not ready for this until later in the year.

**NO DOUBLE PARKING—Not even to drop off elsewhere - NO EXCEPTIONS—NO EXCUSES. THE POLICE WILL TICKET OFFENDERS.**



## Using the Drop-Off And Pick-Up Zone on Murray Avenue

- **NO PARKING OR STANDING** is allowed along Murray Avenue opposite the school during school drop-off and pick-up times. **This means you may not stop at all opposite the school during these hours.**
- In the morning, you may drop-off your child on the school side of Murray Avenue from the beginning of the upper playground to the bus stop near Forest Avenue, including the fire lane. **The driver must remain in the car at all times.** This zone will not be staffed – children who need assistance should use the Daymon Terrace drop-off in the morning.
- In the afternoon, you may wait in your car to meet a child for pick-up on the school side of Murray Avenue, beginning at the upper playground to the bus stop near Forest Avenue, including the fire lane. **The driver must remain in the car at all times. You may not leave your vehicle unattended for any length of time in this zone.**
- There will likely be no spots left on Murray Ave. if you arrive just before or at dismissal time. Consider making a “back-up” plan with your child in the event that you arrive to pick-up a few minutes late and you need to park your car because the Pick-Up Zone is full.

**DO NOT LEAVE YOUR CAR UNATTENDED** in the morning or afternoon in this area. The police will ticket offenders. **Double-parking is never allowed on Murray Ave.**

Following traffic and parking regulations and using the crosswalks ensure our children arrive and depart school safely. We ask all parents, children and caregivers to become familiar with these rules and to follow them.
